

These several motions, if made, shall have precedence in the order above stated, and the first four thereof shall be decided without debate.

4. The previous question shall be put from the chair only after it shall have been ascertained that the call therefor is sustained by a majority of the members, and then shall always be put in the following words :—"Shall the question be now put?" which words shall be understood to have reference to whatever question may be pending immediately before such call for the previous question shall have been so made.

5. Any two members having voted on the majority, may at the same or next regular meeting move for a re-consideration thereof; but no discussion on the main question shall be allowed upon such motion.

6. Every member shall have the privilege of speaking for ten minutes on any subject, and be allowed five minutes
