In point of situation and salubrity this Institution offers many advantages.

The course of study is complete; and the Gold Medal and Diploma of the Institution are conferred on the young lady who graduates.

N. B. A Silver Medal presented by His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of Canada will be awarded at the close of the Scholastic year to the young lady who excels in general proficiency.

The English and French Languages being equally used in familiar conversation, and the best literature of each carefully studied, a classic and idiomatic knowledge of both is thereby ensured.

A special course of Plain Sewing, Dress Cutting, Dress-making and House-keeping is successfully taught.

The Scholastic year is divided into two sessions, beginning respectively with September and February.

*Terms per Session.*—Board, Tuition, Bed and Laundress, \$64. Entrance fee, \$4.

Music, Drawing and Painting form extra charges, as do also Latin, German and Italian and the Course of Calisthenics.

The Costume consists of a black and a white dress. Each pupil should be provided with a sufficient supply of Linen, a Dressing Case, 2 pairs of sheets, 2 pillow cases, 1 black veil 2 yards long, 1 white veil 2½ yards long.

A day school is attached to the Institution, the Terms are—

Music—Piano ".....	7 50
