## XVIII. TABLET READING LESSONS.

**THREE** Graduated Reading Lessons, by Charles Baker: A circle of knowledge. Each Graduation consisting of 200 Lessons. Two chief objects have been kept in view in these Lessons:—1st. To provide a series of school books suitable for elementary classes, and for home instruction at a moderate price, which should comprise information on a range of subjects more connected, extended, and systematic than has ever been introduced into English lesson books. 2ndly. To adapt this information by a graduated series of lessons for children of different ages and degrees of advancement; not graduated by commencing with short words, among which are nearly all the particles—the most difficult words in a language—but by simplicity of ideas, expressed in short, easy and natural sentences.
