

The following Letter was received by the Right Honourable the Lord Mayor, at the Mansion-House.

Downing-Street, March 29, 1802,
Half past 9 o'Clock.

My Lord,

Mr. Moore, Assistant Secretary to Marquis Cornwallis, is just arrived with the Definitive Treaty of Peace, which was signed at Amiens, on the 27th of this month, by his Majesty's Plenipotentiary, and by the Plenipotentiaries of France, Spain, and the Batavian Republic.
