auditorium, its fine organ, its club rooms, and class rooms, its lecture room, and Sabbath School room, its fully furnished kitchen, and gymnasium, heating and ventilating arrangements all compete. No doubt it represents careful planning, iberal giving, skilful workmanship, and industrial achievements of various kinds; but that which gives special significance to the building is not the material structure, but the people that assemble within its walls. Ye, not the building, are the temple of the living God.

That which gives significance to our gathering here is that we are spiritual beings, spiritual worshippers, spiritual workers, engaged in doing things in the realm of spiritual realities.
