Section XIV.—It shall be the imperative duty of all the Committees of the Association to organize immediately after their appointment, elect a Secretary, and keep correct minutes of all their proceedings, to decide what stated meetings they will hold during the year.

Section XV.—It shall also be the duty of all Committees of the Association to report in writing to the Association once a month. The Board shall have the right to call for a report from any of the Committees at any time.

ARTICLE XI.

DISCIPLINE.

No person shall hold any office or position of trust in this Association who shall cease to profess and practice the fundamental doctrines of Evangelical Christianity, and the Board of Directors shall have full power to investigate any questions of the doctrines or conduct of any officer or member of the Association, and upon a two-third $(\frac{2}{3})$ vote of the Board such officer or member may be removed from office or membership.

ARTICLE XII.

AMENDMENTS.

SECTION I.—These By-Laws may be amended by a two-third (23) vote of the members present at any regular meeting of the Association, notice having been given at a previous regular meeting of the proposed amendment.

Section II.—Any By-Law may be suspended by a two-third (%) vote of the members present at any regular business meeting.
