The military forces of Canada or Great Britain in the present war. It is eminently proper and fitting that these women should have a vote, but it is equally fitting and proper that if any woman has a vote that all women should have a vote. The proposition of the Borden Government to establish in Canada a military qualification as a condition precedent to the right of the women to exercise their franchise is the very antithesis of democracy, a reversion to autocracy and an attempt to falsify a caste system upon Canada. Instead of a democratic system, which, until the present franchise act, we had enjoyed.

What True Democracy is.

TRUE DEMOCRACY RESTS ON THE WILL OF THE MAJORITY EXPRESSED THROUGH A FRANCHISE WHICH DRAWS NO DISTINCTION BETWEEN THE RICH OR THE POOR, THE STRONG OR THE WEAK, THE CIVIL OF THE MILITARY, BUT GIVING TO EVERY CITIZEN WHO COMES WITHIN THE OPERATION OF ITS LAWS THE RIGHT TO EXPRESS HIS OPINION IN REGARD TO THESE LAWS AND THE MEN WHO ENACT THESE LAWS.

Today we have a government of the people by a specially selected class of the people for the benefit of Mackenzie & Mann and Sifton and Flavelle. Why were these other women disenfranchised? Why were they not given the vote? Does any man suggest it is because these women are not patriotic or loyal to their native land? Does anybody suggest that these women have not equally with the men the education and the training necessary to enable them to exercise their franchise at the polls? No. Why, then, were these women robbed of their vote and placed in a humiliating position of inferiority to their fellow-citizens? What about the women who in this very room have toiled and labored for three years in their effort to succor the wounded and alleviate the miseries of the heroic soldiers at the front? What crime did they commit that they should be so degraded before the eyes of the world? The answer is that the big interests behind the Borden administration desire to submerge the civilian population of Canada by disenfranchising the electors so that they could create a military caste, which they had hoped to manipulate for their own selfish ends. Such action strikes at the very roots of civil liberty, and instead of uniting the country solidly as it should be behind the soldier and his dependents, tends to disunion and antagonism, when to the soldier is due only honor, admiration and respect.

Take a further instance of the franchise act. Look at the position in which it places the members of the sect known as Quakers. What does this Government say to the Quaker? Every person knows and every Government has always recognized the fact that the Quaker is sincere and true in his belief in non-participation in any war. To the Quaker the Government offers a choice of violating his religion or violating his duty as a citizen. To the Quaker the Government has said, "If you vote you must fight, whatever your religious principles may be." If the Quaker votes he is false to his religious belief. If he abstains from voting he is false to his duties as a citizen. To whom must the Quaker be false? Must he be false to his God or to his country?

I might read on to you section after section of this act, which has the effect of disenfranchising hundreds of thousands of citizens of Canada. I might tell you of the thousands of men and women to whom Canada had pledged his honor by the grant of citizenship, and who today must believe that Canada's pledged word is but a scrap of paper, that will be torn to shreds at any time whenever political necessity demands the return of Government pledged to the interests of Sifton and Flavelle. Such is the tragic story of betrayal of democracy and liberty and justice and honor for the purpose of returning to power the servants of the grafters and profiteers.

Kaiser for Autocracy.

"Who would the Kaiser vote for?" Hugh Guthrie asked, and Dewar has answered, and I answer that the Kaiser would vote for those policies which are the Kaiser's policies, and would vote against those policies which are the policies of democracy and liberty.

Not satisfied with stealing the people's votes, the Borden Government took last month after month of the precious hours of the last session in forcing through the House of Commons by a closure the most outrageous steal that ever disgraced Canadian public life. In 1914 Mackenzie & Mann stole to the House of Commons for forty-five million dollars of the people's money to finance their railway enterprise, which was then approaching bankruptcy. The Government of Sir Robert Borden guaranteed the securities of the Canadian Northern Railway in 1914 for forty-five million dollars. But it was provided by Section 24 of the said act:

"And, whereas, by Section 24 of the said act it is enacted as follows:

"If authorized by the Parliament of Canada the governor-in-council may on such terms and conditions (if any), as Parliament may prescribe at any time while any event of default shall exist and be continuing by order, declare the equity of redemption of the Canadian Northern and of all other persons who own or have a mortgage on premises to be foreclosed, and, thereupon, the equity of redemption of the Canadian Northern (and of such other persons), in the mortgaged premises and every part thereof shall be and become absolutely debared and foreclosed, and the same shall thereupon be vested in his majesty in right of the Dominion of Canada, any statutory enactment or any rule of law or equity to the contrary notwithstanding."

May Get \$10,000,000.

Notwithstanding that the road was bankrupt, that the report of the Drayton-Acworth Commission said the stock was valueless, the Borden Government have provided that a board of arbitrators may, notwithstanding the condition of the road, hand over as much as ten million dollars of the taxpayers' money to Mackenzie & Mann. Nothing so outrageous has ever been witnessed in the public annals of Canada. The slogan of my opponent in London could be summarized in two lines. Millions upon millions for Mackenzie & Mann, and 6-cent bacon for the workman.

The Right Honorable Sir Wilfrid Laurier, in his manifesto, states that if returned to power, the Canadian Northern act will be further considered by the Parliament of Canada. So far as I am concerned, if elected to Parliament, I will vote for the repeal of that portion of the act which gives one copper of the people's money to Mackenzie & Mann, I will vote to hand back the millions of dollars which they would receive from the treasury of Canada to the taxpayers.

Opposes Borden Union.

So far as Union Government is concerned, I am absolutely opposed to the Borden Union Government. Every man and every woman in Canada is in favor of real union government, a real union of all parties, creeds, races and classes, but the present Union Government represents not a union of the forces of the nation, but a union of the forces of the grafters and profiteers. Joseph Flavelle, Mackenzie & Mann, and all the big interests.

Sanctifies the habit occasionally of blurring out the truth regardless of whose head may be hit, and in an interview which appeared in the Toronto Daily Star on Tuesday, October 16th, 1914, what the Union Government really is, was made manifest by one who

actually knows.

"What do you think of the Union Government?" the general was asked. "It is a splendid triumph of the plan laid long ago by Sir Joseph Flavelle and Sir Thomas White," replied Sir Sam.

The real truth of the matter is that both the rank and file of the Conservative party and the rank and file of the Liberal party have been sold to the big interests by the politicians at Ottawa. This is the real situation, and the situation that the people of Canada must realize and face. As for the Liberals who have entered the Union Government and have united forces with Mackenzie & Mann and Sifton and Flavelle, I must confess that I greatly doubt their sincerity or their honesty of purpose.

Called it "Iniquitous."

Frank Carvell stood in the House of Commons and declared "Iniquitous" the franchise act which robbed the people of their votes. Newton Wesley Howell held up his hands in pious horror as from across the road he watched Bob Rogers flinch the ballots of the people. Yet shortly after what do we see? The very men who were loudest in their denunciation of the Borden Government are going to share the spoils. The very men who condemned the theft of the people's ballots by the franchise act are seeking election, and only hoping to procure election by means of that franchise act. To my mind these men are more to be condemned than the men who initiated this legislation.

They are in the position of receivers of stolen goods; they are accessories before the fact to the robbery of the people's votes. I was told that on another day to a man who said he was largely instrumental in forming the Union Government. He was a so-called Liberal. When I asked him what his motive was, he said that with the franchise act the Liberals could not elect a man to Parliament practically in the whole Dominion of Canada, and that it was better to compromise and save something out of the election, and he, therefore, justified the action of the Liberals in entering the Borden Union Government.

So far as I am concerned it is not the primary purpose of Liberalism to elect Liberals to the House of Commons. Liberalism means something far different from that.

A Great Moral Force.

Liberalism should be not a road to office, but a great moral force, standing like a granite wall against those who would steal the people's franchise; standing like Gibraltar against those who would deliver the masses of the nation to the mercies of the privileged few. Better, far better, would it be that no one Liberal should sit in the House of Commons than that Liberalism should be a party to the disenfranchisement of the citizens of Canada, delivering the poor and weak to the tender mercies of the rich and strong, a party to the barter and sale of the liberties of the nation, to the interests that stand behind Sifton and Flavelle. Who stands behind this Union Government? Judge this Government by its friends. WHERE DO MACKENZIE & MANN STAND? SOLID BEHIND THE UNION GOVERNMENT. WHERE DO SIR JOSEPH FLAVELLE AND SIR CLIFFORD SIFTON STAND? SOLID BEHIND THE UNION GOVERNMENT. FROM COAST TO COAST I CHALLENGE ANY MAN TO STAND WITH THE BIG INTERESTS OR WITH THE PEOPLE? That is the question that you must decide. Remember the very men who disenchanted this country for three years, who robbed the people of the franchise, are still sitting in this Government.

With their record in the past, do you dare to trust them in the future? With the long record of shameless administration and shameless legislation, which brought dishonor to the fair name of Canada, can you expect a different history in the next five years? If these men are returned to power merely because a few Grits have gone in to divide the spoils?

False Cries Raised.

These, ladies and gentlemen, are the issues that the citizens of London must face and the question which they must answer. Let every man and woman here, and like practically every man and woman throughout Canada, like the leader of the Liberal party, the Right Honorable Sir Wilfrid Laurier, I am in favor of winning this war. The suggestion made for politics
