

PRICES RESUME UPWARD TREND IN WALL STREET

New Records Achieved by Rail Group—Industrials Also Show Gain.

NEW YORK, Oct. 21.—Stock prices continued to push forward vigorously at the opening of today's market, with the execution of large buying orders, which had accumulated overnight. Southern Railway and Baltimore and Ohio headed a list of new high records in the railroad group, while initial gains of 1 to 3 points, among industrials included General Electric, Pan American "B," Marland Oil, Sears Roebuck, American Waterworks and Chrysler.

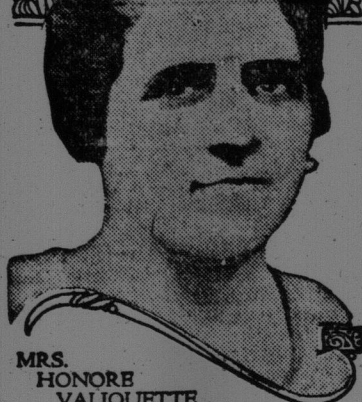

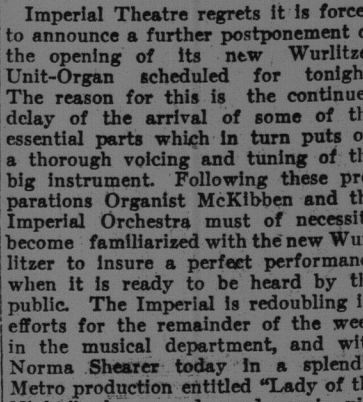

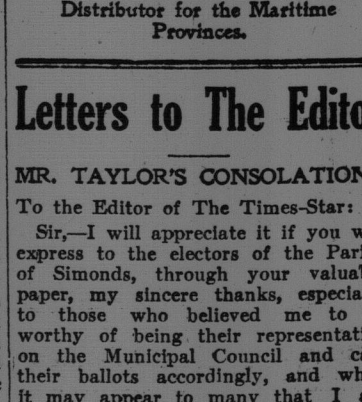
