Dry Dock Day Parade Cost
\$575—Final Meeting
of Committee.

A final meeting of the parade committee, in connection with the opening of the dry dock on Monday, last, was held in the offices of Commissioner John Thornton, Prince William street, last evening. Recommendations will now be sent to the finance and general committee for approval. Commissioner Thornton presided.

A report was received from the judges, Mrs. W. W. White, Judge H. O. McInerney, and B. A. Schofield, as to their awards, viz: Fire Department for best original float; Asryan Association for best fancy float, and to the Police Department for the best appearing body of men in the parade. The judges recommended that the boys of the Rothesay Collegiate School, on account of their excellent marching and appearance, be given a special second prize of \$50. The matter was discussed only a few minutes, when, on motion, the report of the judges was received and the awards ordered paid by the finance and general committee.

The total of \$575.35 for expenses was recommended to the finance and general committee for payment. The total amount was under that asked for by the parade committee.

Votes of thanks were passed to Major George Gamblin and his assistant marshals and others who assisted in the management of the parade.

8 ARE ARRESTED AT NEW YORK MEETING

Agitators Mix it With Po-
lice When Crowds Greet
Lloyd George.

New York, Nov. 2.—Eight persons were arrested near the Metropolitan Opera House, where Lloyd George, war-premier of Great Britain, was speaking tonight, when Irish Republican agitators attempted to hold a mass meeting in the street. Patrolmen's caps were knocked from their heads by placards the agitators were carrying.

Police fought a hand to hand battle with a large group that gathered in 40th street near Broadway. Many carried signs bearing the picture of Eamon De Valera while others were inscribed with phrases uncomplimentary to the British visitor.

Opera House Guarded.

The area about the Metropolitan Opera House was guarded by 250 patrolmen and 150 detectives. Before Mr. Lloyd George arrived the crowds that pressed about to catch a glimpse of him were so great that a traffic jam resulted.

Mounted police finally charged the crowd that surged about the bluecoats. Hundreds of persons were driven back to Sixth avenue, while here and there a patrolman grabbed one of the group and placed them under arrest. Several of those so caught were women.

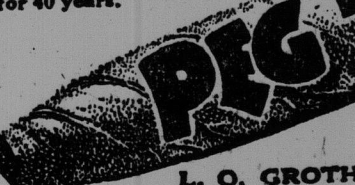

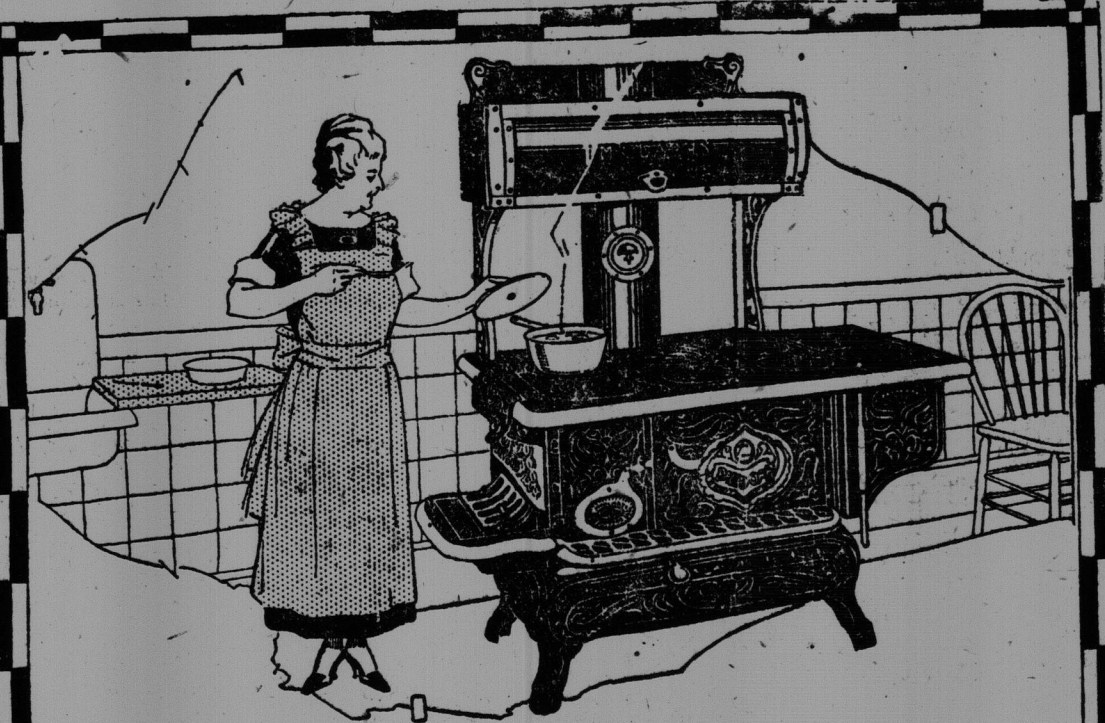
The concluding address was given by Dr. G. J. Trueman, president of Mount Allison University, who spoke on "Learning and Remembering."

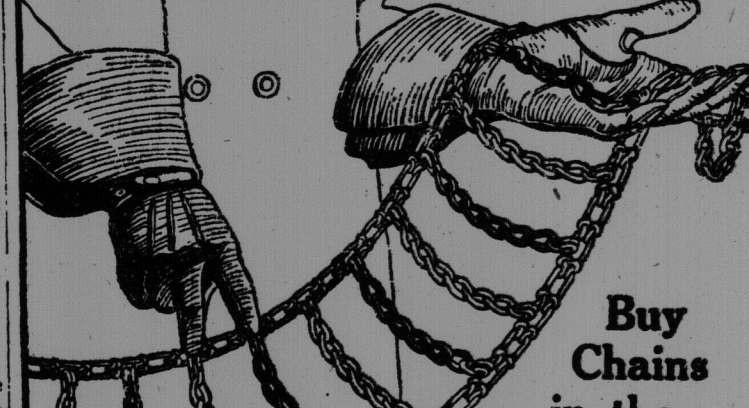

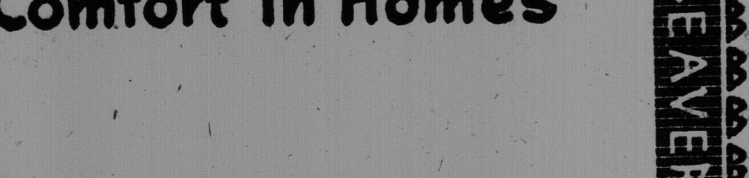
