



MOVIES IN ARGENTINA.

The United States has no monopoly of moving picture fans. There are 128 moving picture theatres running in Buenos Aires, with paid admissions averaging 2,250,000 a month. The theatres are run on a somewhat curious principle, according to our ideas. Although the pictures are repeated several times the patron buys an admission for a single picture or for the entire show as desired. There are two shows a day in all the theatres, but in a single theatre is there a continuous performance as in the United States.

Although the two Americas are populated by different races with very different temperaments and tastes in many respects, the South Americans much prefer the films made in the United States to those manufactured in Europe. The Americans prefer to pay the additional price. A European film is occasionally introduced for the sake of variety, but the American pictures are the recognized standard.
