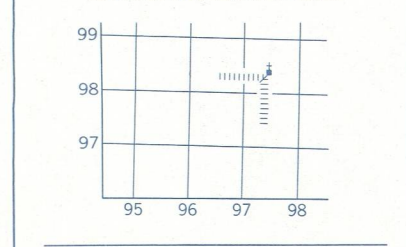

REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (see above)
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point	97
Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point	5
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point	97.5
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	98
EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	975984
Nearest similar grid reference	100,000 metres (about 63 miles)

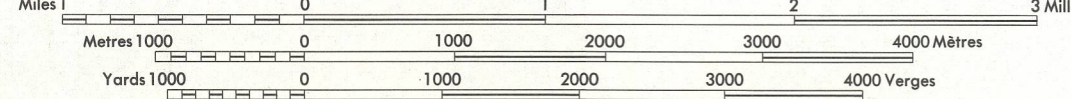
