THE THAW TRIAL

NEW YORK, Feb. 14.—Because of the serious illness of Mrs. Joseph B. Bolton, wife of a juror, there is some fear that there will be a mis-trial in the Thaw case. Mrs. Bolton, who is 55 years old, is suffering from double pneumonia and is now passing through the crisis of the disease. Her physician says he cannot hold any possible hope of her recovery.

After court adjourned yesterday the will was turned over to District Attorney Jerome, that he might study it and decide whether he would object to its admission. If he does not Evelyn Thaw will be called on the stand to continue her testimony, interrupted for the purpose of allowing the experts to tell of Thaw's mental condition.

All twelve of the Thaw jurors were on hand at the opening of court this morning. The names of the jurors are: Joseph B. Bolton, who is suffering from double pneumonia, continues in a critical condition, however, and her husband may be called away at any time.
