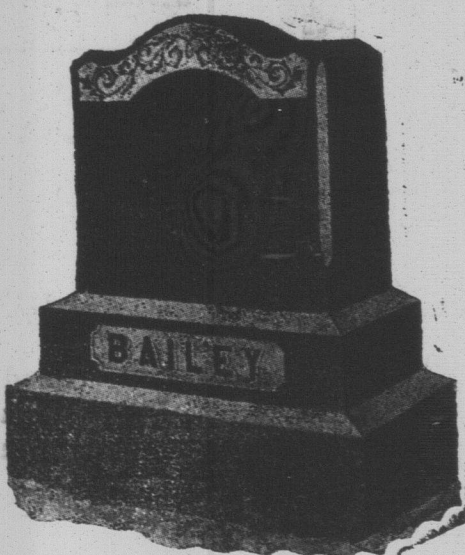

#### Prince of Wales Growing Popular

LONDON, July 3.—There can be no doubt that the public is at last beginning to realize that the Prince of Wales is a strong personality in spite of his rather insignificant appearance. He is every day adding to his popularity and he has vastly impressed the delegates who came from the remotest parts of the British Empire to attend the Imperial Press Conference.

When he invited the delegates to a garden party at Marlborough House, at which both King and Queen were present, he caused telegrams to be sent to every London newspaper saying that he emphatically desired that no description of the party should be published. The editors at once recognized that the Prince wished to meet the Colonial editors in an entirely friendly and unofficial manner, and all of them respected his wishes.

The party was absolutely informal and the Princess of Wales was never seen to better advantage. She has lost all traces of her stiffness due to nervousness which kept her rather at a distance from the public, and she talked in a most animated manner and with a good deal of knowledge to the Colonial and Indian delegates.

The Prince has greatly added to his popularity by his tour of the Duchy of Cornwall and Devon, where he owns vast estates which will pass to his eldest son. In the old days the estates were abominably managed and "Graft" was written over the face of them. Queen Victoria changed all that and not only saw that the tenants were properly cared for, but increased the revenue from the estates. In 1887 the payments made for the then Prince of Wales amounted to \$195,000. Today the Prince of Wales is drawing over \$400,000 from Cornwall and Devon and the tenants there are carefully housed and cared for. The Prince of Wales is working with tremendous enthusiasm, too, over the rebuilding of his London slum property. As the leases fall in he is building the most up-to-date workman dwellings where artisans can live in flats with bathrooms, for two dollars a week. When Prince Edward of Wales comes to the throne the whole of this vast property will be a "workman's paradise."

#### Clock Made of Bicycles.

A clever Frenchman named Alphonse Duhamel has instructed a timepiece twelve feet high, composed entirely of bicycles of their component parts. The framework is a huge bicycle wheel, round which are arranged twelve ordinary sized wheels, all fitted with pneumatic tires. A rim within the large wheel bears the figures for the hours, the figures themselves being constructed of crank rods. The hands being constructed of steel tubing which is used for the framework of bicycles. The minute strokes on the dial are small nickel-plated pieces. The top of the clock is an arrangement of twelve handle bars. The clock strikes the hours and the quarters, bicycle bells, of course making the chiming. The pendulum is made of various parts of a bicycle frame. It is said that the clock, besides being a curiosity, is an excellent timepiece.

#### On Eating too Much.

Overeating is always dangerous, but for the old and for women it is especially bad. As age advances well meaning friends and relatives are only apt to think that extra nourishment and support are necessary, doing much harm thereby. Certainly any change in the diet should be gradual and not sudden. Large heavy meals are especially to be avoided. Small meals, consisting of easily digested materials, should follow one another at not too long intervals. Meat should be taken only in moderation, while the vegetable food may be somewhat increased.
