they placed their services unconditionally at the service of the Governor if he was about to take personal command of the whole bolonial force in the field.

15. The Governor, impressed with the belief that to accept the perhaps hasty resignation of a high stirited and valuable body of men, who had come forward to assist the Colony at a time of difficulty, would bear an appearance of ingratitude, and be detrimental to the public interesto modified his arrangements. M. Cox's harty would return to the Poute Inlet country and resume their interrupted operations. The men from New Westminoter, whose discihave was equal to their cheerful endurance of dangers and privations, would co-operate with them, as M. Drew might judge expedient, either by marching in full force against the Indians, or by doing so weakened by detaching some men to hold Benohie . The alexandria party, assisted by alexis and his followero, will therefore proceed from the old Andson's Bay fort down the Chiles Piver, towards Teloots position on the head waters of the Memaia. M. Brew will approach, with probably only a portion of his force, the same shot, by the Country previously traversed by Me faithful box in which Me Lean fell. The faithful
