An Act to make certain provisions with regard to Common Schools in Upper Canada for a limited period.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make some further provision Preamble. for the improvement of Common Schools in Upper Canada, and to modify and extend some of the provisions of the Act thirteenth and fourteenth Victoria, chapter forty-eight, intituled An Act for the better establishment and maintenance of Common 13 and 14 Vic. Schools in Upper Canada; Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's c. 48, cited. Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under Othe authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Board of School Trustees in each City Powers of Town an Incorporated Village, shall, in addition to the powers' Trustees with which they are now legally invested, possess and exercise, extended. as far as they shall judge expedient, in regard to each such City, Town and Incorporated Village, all the powers with which the Trustees of each School Section are or may be invested by law in ⁰ regard to each such School Section.
