7. That your petitioner has not in any way condoned the adultery committed by the said C. D. and that no collusion or connivance exists between your petitioner and the said C. D. to obtain a dissolution of their said marriage.

Your petitioner therefore humbly prays:

That your Honourable House will be pleased to pass an Act dissolving the said marriage between your petitioner and the said C. D. and enabling your petitioner to marryagain, and giving to your petitioner the custody of the said Mary D. and Elizabeth D., and granting your petitioner such further and other relief in the premises as to your Honourable House may seem meet.

And as in duty bound your petitioner will ever pray.
