spective Courts of Civil and Criminal Jurisdiction, then existing in this Province, and which are not expressly repealed or altered, or varied by this Act, shall remain and continue in force, and be observed by the Court of King's Bench and District Courts respectively hereby constituted, and by the Justices and Judges thereof respectively.

LIX. And be it further enacted, that nothing addictive powers herein contained shall affect or be construed to by Law vested in the Judges of affect, in any manner or way, the powers and the Courts of Gaspé and St. authorities which by Law are now vested in the Judges of the Provincial Court of Gaspé, and of the Inferior District of St. François, or any or either of them, and that the Division of the Court of King's Bench hereby constituted for the District of Quebec shall have hold and exercise the same powers and authorities with respect to the Inferior District of Gaspé, as were by Law held and exercised by the Court of King's Bench of and for the District of Quebec at the passing of this Act, and that the Division of the Court of King's Bench hereby constituted for the District of Three Rivers, shall also have hold and exercise the same powers and authorities with respect to the Inferior District of St. François, as were by Law held and exercised by the Court of King's Bench of and for the said District of Three Rivers at the passing of this Act.
