

that fuch Ship, Veffel, or Boat, fhall not be employed, or be found or difcovered to have been out of the Limits within which fuch Ship, Veffel, or Boat, fhall or may be licenfed to navigate or trade, contrary to the Directions and Provisions of an Act, paffed in the Twenty-feventh Year of the Reign of His prefent Majesty, for making further Provisions in regard to fuch Veffels as are particularly defcribed in an Act, made in the Twenty-fourth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majesty, for the more effectual Prevention of Smuggling in this Kingdom, and for extending the faid Act to other Veffels and Boats not particularly defcribed therein, and for other Purpofes; and alfo that fuch Ship, Veffel, or Boat, fhall not be engaged for or ufed in any Trade or Employment whatever, other than that defcribed and fet forth in the Licence for fuch Ship, Veffel, or Boat, contrary to an Act, paffed in the Thirty-eighth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majesty, to prevent Veffels licenfed by the Admiralty from being engaged in any Trade or Employment not permitted by their Licences; and alfo that fuch Ship, Veffel, or Boat, fhall not be ufed or employed in any other Way or Manner whatever, contrary to the Laws in force relating to the Revenue of Customs on and immediately before the paffing of this Act.

and alfo that the Veffel fhall not be engaged in any other Trade or Employment than what is fet forth in the Licence, &c.
