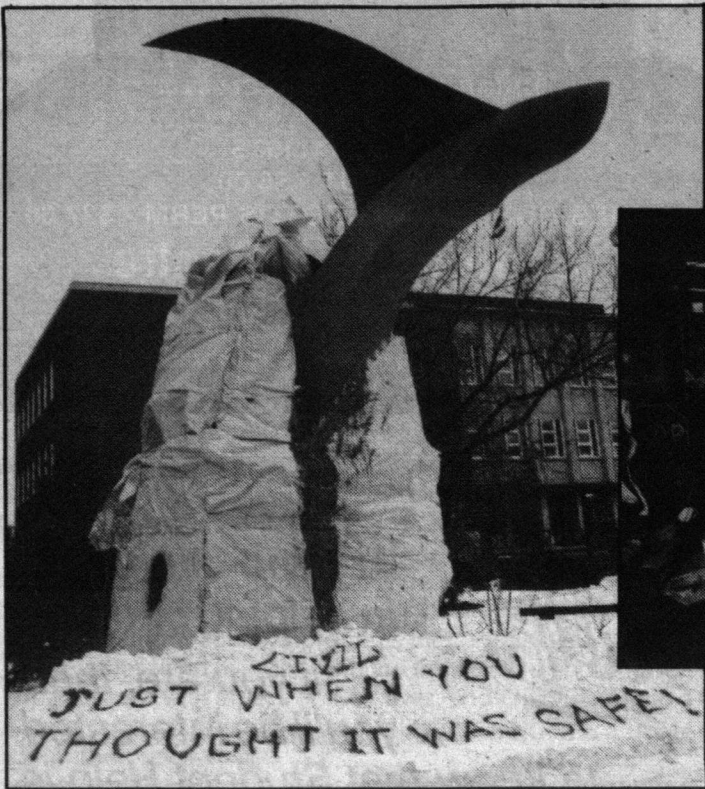

Engineering Week has always been full of surprises and this year has been no exception. As usual, it was tasteless, tacky, rude, sexist and enjoyed by all ...

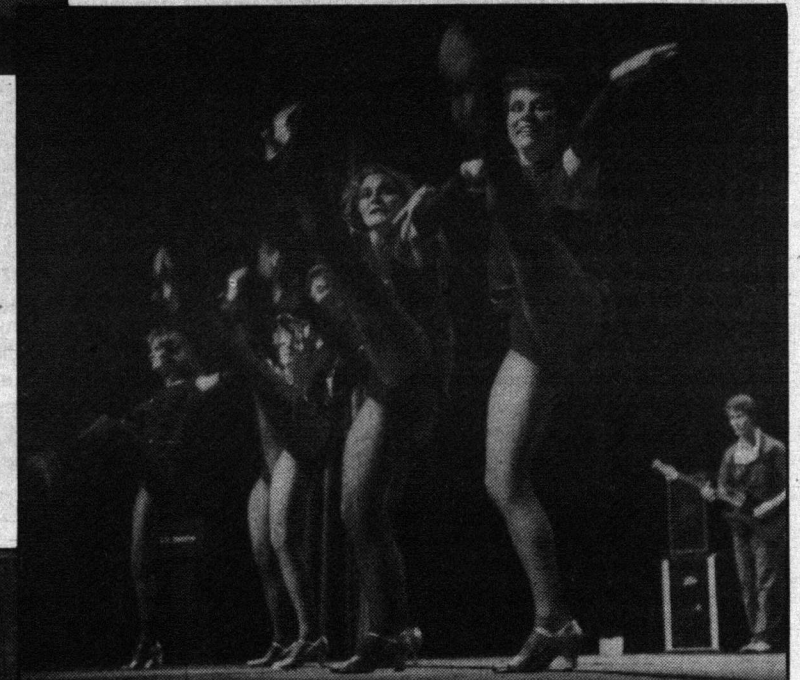

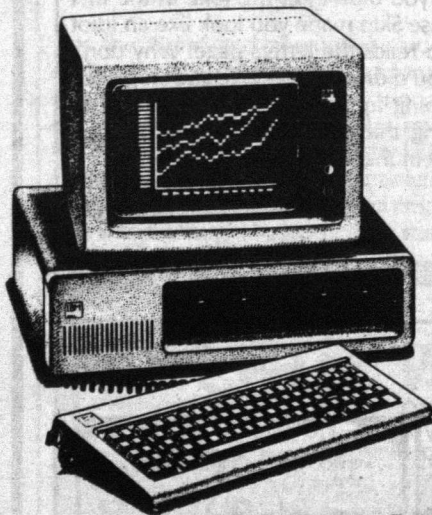
