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By this morning's Post  
came a letter from London  
(which I enclose) and another  
from Mons de Riverbelle  
offering to send you the  
Statistic Returns of Indians  
for 1840 if you desire to  
have them and requesting  
your answer immediately.

A person from the Land  
Commissioners' office called  
about a lot in Rawdon.  
It seems that in your  
schedule referred by the  
Governor General to that

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Office the lot is numbered  
No 5 and 6 in the 11<sup>th</sup>  
Range and the Land Agent  
in that Township reports  
that No 7 in 11<sup>th</sup> Range is  
occupied by one Michel an  
Indian - now by your  
mem<sup>o</sup> of 4<sup>th</sup> June 39 - I find  
that "Michel Nicholas an Amalite  
of River St John has occupied during  
20 years No 10 in 11<sup>th</sup> Range  
of Rawdon on which he has 10  
Acres cleared and a house."  
The Crown Land Com<sup>r</sup> wishes to  
know which lot is the one occupied  
by Michel before he makes his  
Report to His Excellency
