Dear Sirs:

Re: Your file 360,260.

Referring to your letter of January 9th last in connection with right of way of the G.T.P. Branch Lines Company through the South West quarter of 12-20-15 West 2nd and also the Pasqua Indian Reserve. There has been a great deal of confusion over the right of way through these two portions and from our files it would appear that we now hold title No.156 W.E. covering the right of way through the Pasqua Indian Reserve on the unsurrendered portion but we are not able to find anything in our files showing that patent has issued for our right of way through the South West quarter of 12-20-15 West 2nd.

In a letter to you dated ^{Dec} ~~September~~ 8th, 1910, we forwarded to you transfer for registration and also your necessary fees, covering this quarter and in a letter from you dated 14th March, 1911, you acknowledged receipt of this transfer and informed us that it had been entered and accepted and that patent would issue in due course. Although we wrote you several times in connection with this, through the confusion of mistaking this quarter for that of the Indian Reserve we were never
