Fort George 2^d September 1818

Having recently had occasion to refer to the Documents in my possession, relative to the Management of the Land concerns of the Lip Nation Indians residing on the Grand River above Trustee Lane, I perceive that two material papers are wanting - This circumstance must have arisen probably from their being a stop of Papers and Records of the Department which I sent to York for safety during the War, and fell into the hands of the Enemy when that place was taken, & this however of the Documents in question, having been transmitted by me to the Lieut. Governor's office, must now be either in that office, or in that of the Executive Council. I therefore very respectfully request, that His Excellency his Person
