Dear Sir:-

Referring to your letter of the 29th of September, enquiring as to the Soldier Settlement loan of Charles Provost, I would advise that if he pays \$50.00 before the end of November, his loan will be paid in full.

In regard to the bonus credit shown in the statement, I would advise that his payment of \$10.64 made in October, 1935, together with previous payments of annual instalments and bonus allowed created a credit of \$17.40 in the arrears section of his loan account. While this could not be used as a credit against the principal sum of the loan, it was sufficient to earn a bonus of 30% on the 1935 and 1937 instalments as they became due.
