Dear Miss Whitton:

Your letter of 12th is received
this morning.

The reasons for rejecting the clause
which you wished restored are contained in the
remarks made in the Senate by various members, but
particularly by Senator Dandurand. It does not
appear to me that they are answered in the memorandum
which you were good enough to send me.

I am personally anxious not to stand in
the way of any essential and defensible legislation
on this subject, and I feel the Senate would not
object to such an amendment in the Commons as would
not be open to the special objection raised by
Senator Dandurand and concurred in by myself and
others.
