

Sir, With reference to your communication of the 5th instant, and the resolution passed by the Cape Croker Indian Council in regard to the case of John Taylor who desires to receive a loan of \$150.00 from band funds to aid him in building a house on his location, I beg to say that the Department does not approve of loaning money from the Cape Croker Band funds for the erection of dwelling houses. More particularly is the Department opposed to making a loan for such a purpose when, as in the present instance, there is only the interest money of one person available towards re-payment. The loan applied for by Taylor can not therefore be granted.
