In 1905 you reported to the effect that the Indians refused to go to Oromocto or to the Tobique Reserves. If you think this questionshould be again taken up kindly again examine into the matter at your convenience and report further and especially in the directions referred to in letter to you of the 3rd Oct. 1905.


