



Sir,-

Referring to letters and enclosures of the 18th Sept., 1905 relating to removal of the St. Marys reserve Indians I beg to inform you that Mr. M. W. Brown, School Inspector, has recommended that these Indians be transferred to the Oromocto reserve. In 1905 you reported to the effect that the Indians refused to go to Oromocto or to the Tobique Reserves. If you think this question should be again taken up kindly again examine into the matter at your convenience and report further and especially in the directions referred to in letter to you of the 3rd Oct. 1905.
