As to letter of 10th December 1910 to C.H. McNider I have to say that the interest should have been \$5,383.05 instead of 9,697.17.

Halsey's letter of 23rd November 1909 shows the 2nd instalment due and that of 1st December 1910, no 1909, shows the 2nd and 3rd instalments owing to the fact the the 1909 payment was not made.
