control, in terms of United Nations strategic and political needs in preventing future Japanese aggression. It would be desirable from the Canadian point of view that the Loochoo Islands be placed under some system of international control similar to that obtaining in Micronesia. The most appropriate power to assume the administration of this trust territory would be the United States of America.

## G. Bonin Islands, Volcano Islands, Marcus Island:

These islands are located between the Trust territory of the Pacific Islands (former Japanese Mandated Islands) and Japan proper. As the principal islands in a wide area comprising several hundreds of small islands, the most practical disposition of these islands would be their incorporation into an International Trusteeship as part of the Trust territory of the Pacific Islands under the Administrative Authority of the United States of America.
