

SUPPLEMENT TO PIQUET STANDING ORDERS.

29 Oct 43

108 Cdn. Anti-Tank Battery. R.C.A.

1. Any civilians requesting entry to RHA or BHQ will produce their Identity Cards, the sentry will check the photo with the persons appearance and check the signature on the card with the signature that the person writes in the Book. If for any of the above reasons the sentry is suspicious, the person will be placed under arrest and taken to the Guard Room. The NCO I/c of the Piquet will then notify the Battery Orderly Officer.
2. Any Officers not known to the Sentry will also produce their Identity Cards, showing photo and signature, these will be checked. If suspicions are aroused the Officer will be taken to the Guard Room and the Battery Orderly Officer notified immediately.
3. O/R's, not known to the sentry, and desiring admittance, will produce their M.M.L. (Paybook). The Sentry will ask them, when he has the Paybook, Date of Birth, Place and Date of Enlistment, and Dates of Courses or Promotions if any, and check the replies given with the Dates in the Paybook. If Part II of the Paybook is also handed over the Signature will be checked with the Signature written in the Book. If any suspicions arise the soldier will be placed under arrest and taken to the Guard Room, and the Orderly Officer notified.
4. The Sentry will check up on any persons loitering around the building and if they are unable to give a satisfactory explanation for their actions, they will be taken to the Guard Room and the Orderly Officer notified.
5. Sentries will make a practice of reporting any suspicious incidents, no matter how trivial they may seem, to the NCO I/c Piquet, who will turn in his report to the Battery Orderly Officer.
