WILLIAMSON, HENRY CARSON—Corporal. Born 21st April, 1895, at Dundalk, Ireland. Father, Heuston Maxwell Williamson, Timber, Iron and Slate Merchant. Educated at Wesley College, Dublin, Ireland. Entered the service of the Bank, 2nd August, 1912. Enlisted, March, 1916, from Athabasca branch, in 63rd Canadian Battalion, with the rank of Private. Transferred to 115th Canadian Battalion, 21st April, 1916; 13th Reserve Battalion, January, 1917; 26th Canadian Battalion, April, 1917; 13th Reserve Battalion, August, 1917. Promoted Lance-Corporal, 8th May, 1918; Corporal, 11th September, 1918. Service: Joined 26th Canadian Battalion after the battle of Vimy Ridge, April, 1917, also served as Bombing Instructor in England. Fractured ankle (accident), June, 1917. Returned to duty with the Bank, 7th June, 1919.

*WILLIAMSON, JAMES—Private. Born 21st August, 1896, at Aberdeen, Scotland. Father, James Williamson, Manufacturer. Educated at Crypt Grammar School, Gloucester, England. Entered the service of the Bank, 6th April, 1914. Enlisted, October, 1914, from Hanna branch, in 31st Canadian Battalion, with the rank of Private. Service: With his Battalion in France. Wounded (shrapnel), 17th April, 1916.

Killed in Action, 26th September, 1916, by a sniper.

Wilson, Adam—Captain. Born 30th August, 1884, at Dalkeith, Scotland. Father, Andrew Wilson (deceased). Educated at Roslin Public School, Leith Academy, and Heriot-Watt College, Edinburgh. Entered the service of the Bank, 12th November, 1907. Enlisted, 8th February, 1915, from West End, Sault Ste. Marie branch, in 37th Canadian Battalion, with the rank of Lieutenant and Paymaster. Transferred to 116th Canadian Battalion, 1st November, 1915; 182nd Canadian Battalion, 1st July, 1916. Promoted Captain, 1st February, 1916. Served as Paymaster and as Adjutant in England (medically unfit for active service). Demobilized, 26th May, 1917, on account of being medically unfit for further military service. Enlisted, 23rd June, 1915, from Melville branch, in 45th Canadian Battalion, with the rank of Private. Transferred to 78th
