The Council have to acknowledge the very important services rendered to the work of the Association by the Secretary, Lt.-Col. Stuart, and in the onerous duties of Treasurer, Lt.-Col. Powell has proved the wisdom of the Association in the selection of that Officer for the responsible position.

The Council feel that they cannot in justice close this Report without a full expression of thanks for the unwearied support and encouragement afforded to it by the Adjutant General of the Dominion, Colonel MacDougall, whose services, it is to be trusted, may long be retained in the country.
