### PRAYERS.

Read the proceedings of yesterday.

On motion, the bill intituled “an act to continue and amend an act of the 6th year of his present Majesty’s reign, intituled an act for the Encouragement of Education in the different Counties and Districts in this Island,”—received the third reading, and passed, with the following amendments:

In the continuing clause, substitute the word “*Three*” instead of the word “*Ten*,”—and ordered to be sent down to the House of Assembly for their concurrence.

On motion, the bill intituled “an act to continue and alter an act made and passed in the 8th year of his present Majesty’s reign, intituled an act to revive, alter, and continue an act made and passed in the 6th year of his present Majesty’s reign, intituled an act for encreasing the Revenue by levying an additional Duty on all Wines, Gin, Brandy, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, imported into this Island; and to repeal and amend certain parts of an act passed in the 25th year of his late Majesty’s reign, intituled an act to amend, render more effectual, and to reduce into one act, the several Laws made by the General Assembly of this Island relative to the duties of Impost on Wines, Rum, Brandy, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors; and for allowing a Drawback upon all Wines, Rum, Brandy, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors exported from this Island; and to appropriate the monies hereby granted,”—received the second and third, reading, passed, and ordered to be sent down to the House of Assembly.

On motion, the bill intituled “an act to render perpetual an act intituled an act to enable the Justices of the Supreme Court of Judicature to issue Commissions for examining Witnesses out of this Island,”—received the third reading, was passed, and a Message ordered to be sent down to the House of Assembly to acquaint them therewith.
