A despatch from Geneva says the corn harvest in that country is a good one.

A colossal bronze statue of Burns for New York has just been completed by Sir John Steell.

It is reported that Dr. A. C. Tait, Bishop of Canterbury, is about to marry a lady well known in London society.

Chicago advices state that the Illinois cotton crop will be 22,500,000 lbs. less than that of 1879, and about fifteen days late.

An Edinburgh despatch states that the Miller's first farmhouse at Leith was burned this morning. Damage, £25,000. No details are given.

A Paris despatch says the Countess de Tully is on trial for throwing a stone at her husband's mistress, has been acquitted.

A despatch from the Vatican to Madrid reports that the Pope has accepted the position of godfather to the expected heir to the Spanish throne.

A Constantinople despatch says it is reported that the Sultan's Prime Minister, Kadri Pasha, has resigned, and that a new Cabinet is forming.

The troops of the Emperor of Russia, who were yesterday at the head of the army, are to be sent to the front.

A Berlin despatch states that the Prince of Bulgaria has arrived at Vienna to be interviewed by Prince Bismarck on affairs affecting the joint interests of Germany and Bulgaria.

A Berlin despatch says the last obstacle to the appointment of Count von Hatzfeldt as Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs has been removed.

A St. Petersburg despatch says the appointment of Gen. G. Chicherin, hitherto Secretary of the third section of the Imperial chancery, as his minister-secretary, are gazetted.

A Paris despatch says Ulysses Parent, a member of the municipal council, was arrested on the 26th inst. for having written an article in the 'Liberator' in which he had attacked the first Versailles court-martial who was acquitted.

A London despatch says in consequence of the heavy shipments of gold to America to meet exchange balances the Bank of England has raised its rate of discount from 4 to 5 per cent, and that the Bank of England will raise its rate.

The Attorney-General, Sir Henry James, has consented that the appeal of the defendant in the Tichborne case should come before the Judicial Committee of the House of Lords. It is understood that this is done in order to prevent the people who have been interested in the case from being disappointed.

The arrangements with the syndicate for the construction of the Canadian Pacific railway are progressing very satisfactorily. It is almost unnecessary to say that the settlement of the details in the future will be largely laborious, but the British capitalists and the Ministers are working together most harmoniously, and the final and complete agreement will probably be made within a few days.

At this juncture, however, it will be manifestly imprudent to disclose the details of the terms, but the Canadian interests will not suffer in the former's hands, and that the members of the syndicate are acting liberally towards him.

James Caird, the eminent agricultural authority, writes to the 'Times' that the agricultural returns of Great Britain and Ireland compared with 1878, a slight increase in the crops, but a decrease of seven and a half per cent in wheat, and scarcely any change in oats. He says the quality and yield of wheat are so greatly superior, that if the present splendid harvest were continued for a fortnight, we may secure a crop of from three to four million quarters, or nearly two months' consumption better than in 1878.

Potatoes promise most favourably. The clear weather will go far to check the further progress of the disease. The grass and green crops, except in the lowlands, are abundant, and the hay crop is much damaged by rain but will be largely supplemented by the heavy second crop.
