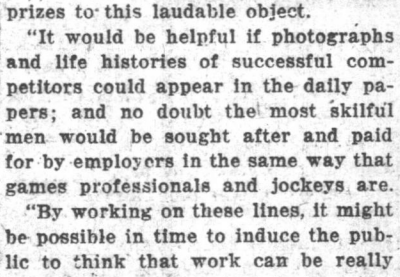

PRUNE WHIP

1 1/2 lb. prunes, 1/2 cup sugar, 1 teaspoon lemon juice, 5 egg whites. Wash prunes and soak in cold water overnight. Cook in same water until soft. Remove stones and rub through strainer, add sugar and cook five minutes. Beat egg whites stiff, fold in prune mixture and pour on buttered dish, and bake twenty minutes in slow oven, or until brown.
