HAY, OATS AND HOGS THE LARGEST OFFERINGS

Dressed Pork Sold at \$11.50
to \$11.75 Per Cwt.
Today.

Hay, oats and dressed hogs were the largest offerings on the local market today, and owing to the large number of sales in the earlier part of the week, the transactions today were dull.

Some 15 loads of hay were sold at various prices from \$1.75 to \$2.25 per ton, but the average selling price was \$2.25 per ton.

Only a few loads of oats were offered, and the price was \$1.10 per cwt. No wheat or straw offered.

Dressed hogs were fairly plentiful, and the most of the sales were made at \$11.50 per cwt, although three or four lots were sold at \$11.75. No other kinds of meats were brought to the market today.

The offerings of butter and eggs were very small, and there were no changes in the prices.
