Soldier's Bride Crosses Atlantic On Leaky Transport



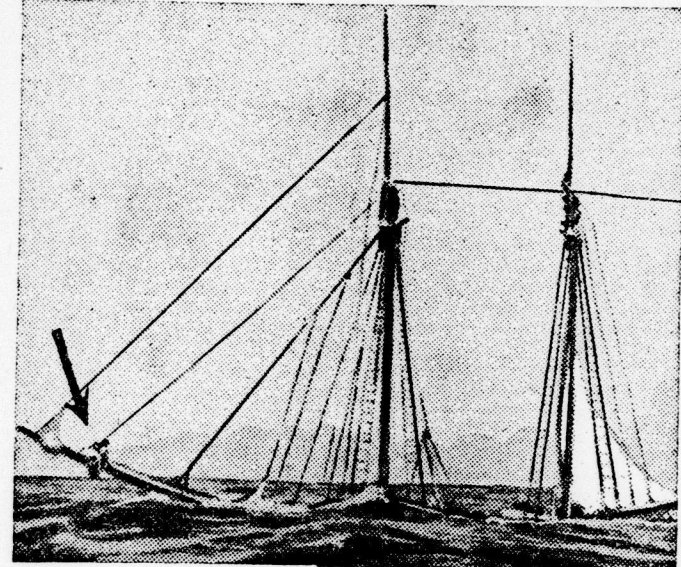

Nervy Maiden To Defy Niagara



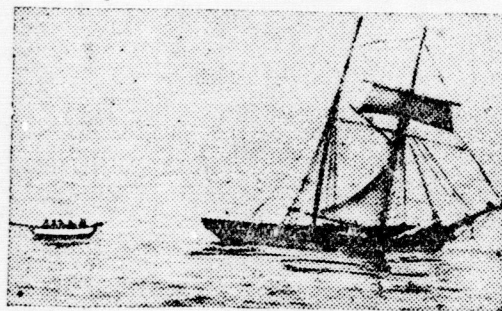
Mlle. ELANORE, an English girl, is coming to Canada to endeavor to repeat Blondin's feat in walking a tight rope across Niagara Falls.

Body of Pontiff Lay in Sistine Chapel



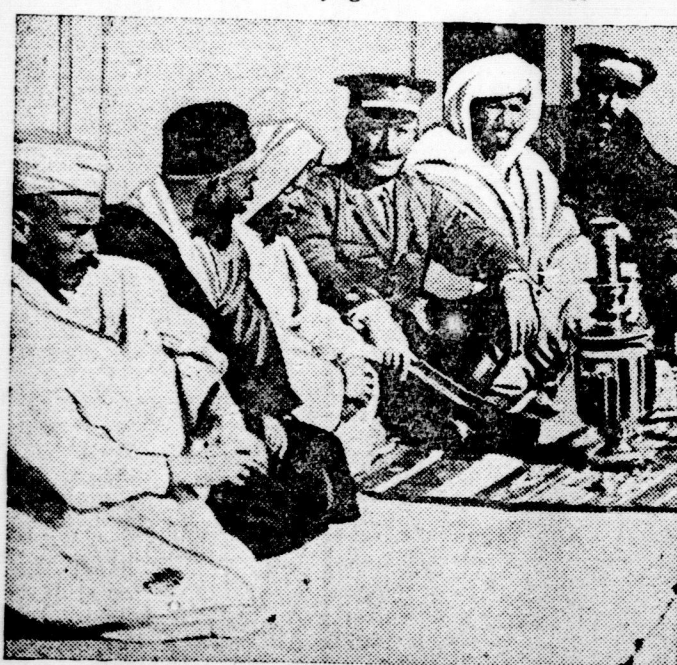
AWAITING burial, Pope Benedict reposed in state in the famous edifice, where many of his predecessors have lain before.

Women Take Control of Swiss City



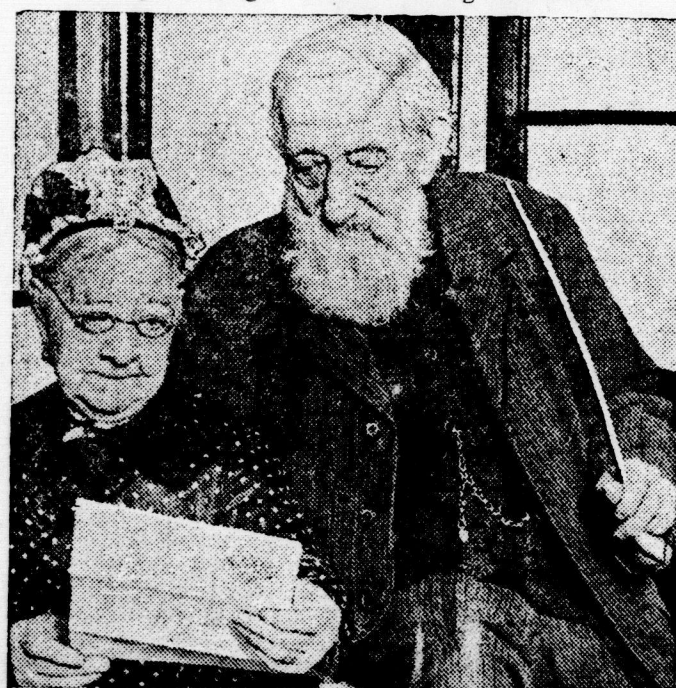
CHAMPERY, Switzerland, municipal affairs are entirely in control of its women citizens. The officials dress in the masculine attire of the former officers.
