The stocker and feeder trade in the west continues good, with prices well sustained. Prices here for all good quality are the same. The quality of the fat cattle on Friday's market was not very good. but better quality is looked for, as it is in good demand.

Sheep and Lambs.

These have been in liberal supplies at Buf falo, though the general demand has been fair ly active and prices strong. Prices for heep here remain unchanged, ewes bringing \$3.25 to \$3.45 in bulk, with choice picked lots at \$3.50 per cwt. Bucks bring \$2.50 to \$2.75 per cwt. Prices for lamber space from \$2.50 to \$2.75 per cwt. Prices for lambs range from \$3.00 to 34-10 per cwt. the latter being for ewes and wethers only.

The market shows some advances over last week's quotations. Choice selections of best bacon hogs, 160 to 220 lbs each, off cars bring \$4.37 to \$4.50 per cwt.; thick fat hogs feich \$4.25, and light fats about \$4. Too many light hogs are coming forward, and dealers are petting more particular every day. The English market for Canadian Jacon re mains steady at last week's prices, and quota tions are 45% to 49 for No. 1, and 40% to 428 for fat and stout sides.
