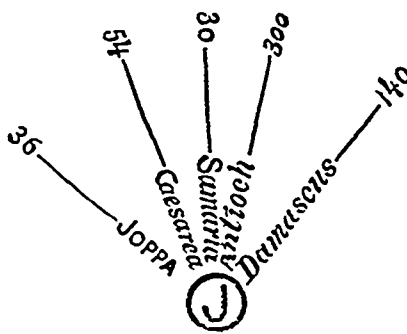

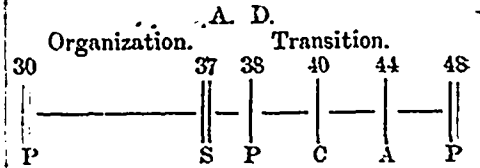
4TH DRILL, SEPTEMBER 25TH.—CHRON-

This period includes about eleven years, from the death of Stephen, A. D. 37, to Paul's first missionary tour, A. D. 48.

Five dates are prominent, some of which are in doubt:

1. Stephen's death, A. D. 37.
2. Paul's conversion, A. D. 38.
3. Cornelius' conversion, A. D. 40.
4. Antioch Church organized and Herod's persecution of the Jerusalem Church—about 44 or 45 A. D.
5. Paul's first missionary tour, A. D. 48.
