CONDITION OF THE MARKET.

With the country trade the demand for builders supplies is keeping up fairly well. General hardware is moving freely, the demand being mostly for shelf goods. A moderate jobbing improvement is reported in lead pipe and galvanized iron. Iron pipe is quiet and prices remain unchanged. The arrivals of cement in Montreal for last week were 2,000 barrels of Belgian. The total receipts at that port for the season up to date are 15,750 barrels of English and 15,025 Belgian, as against 12,000 and 15,075 barrels last year. Business in that line is very limited. The price of glass is unsatisfactory, and cutting is being practiced. We quote \$1.20 to \$1.25 for first break.
