

In this connexion, the UNAM asked that books on applied linguistics and the development of foreign-language teachers be included amongst Canadian donations.

In addition, the SRE requested 30 current Canadian titles in the social sciences and history, for the IMRED.

71. The two Parties will exchange art journals and magazines.

Canada will send copies of art publications produced by the Government of Canada.

72. The two Parties will exchange publications in the areas of anthropology, history, and folklore.

For this purpose, the INAH provided a copy of its publications catalogue.

The AUCC will provide a list of Canadian institutions that might be interested in this exchange.

73. The INAH offered to assist any Canadian publishing firms that might be interested in publishing the documents it produces.

74. The two countries' public archives will exchange information, publications, and books.

In addition, each country will offer assistance to researchers from the other country for the purposes of locating, listing, and copying documents of historical relevance held in its archives.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.
