- C.A.T. Gallery participated in Venice Biennale from May through November 1986. Project involved organizing an electronic media workshop and slow-scan T.V. and facsimile broadcast called C.A.T./SCAN from Toronto to Venice Biennale as part of the UBIQUA exhibit. 15 1-hour transmissions/exchanges with several other international sites were also held. A video of project will be available in near future. C.A.T. Gallery is an alternate gallery which is quite well known within small but diverse international field of electronic media. It initiates non-commercial telecommunication projects in collaboration with artists around the world.

- The Photo/Electric Arts Foundation co-ordinated the participation of Canadian artists and speakers, known as the Strategic Arts Initiative (S.A.I.), at ARTMEDIA II, the second Colloquium of Art and communication media at the University of Salerno in May 26-30, 1986. It received good press coverage in Italy. Canadian group was recognized for its technological skill.

- Ontario theatre company (45.3 Inc.) sponsored a visit by 3 Italian Commedia artists from the mimoteatromovimento to give public workshops on the Italian Commedia dell'Arte and rehearse with its company from May - July, 1986.
