

- The Canada-CARICOM Community Scholarship Program enables management-level participants from Belize to study at Canadian institutions. The program supports human resource development in key economic sectors such as public administration, tourism, agriculture and industry.
- Belize will also benefit from three new regional projects that will be put in place in the fall of 1996:
 - i) the Women in Development/Gender Equity Project;
 - ii) the HIV/AIDS prevention project to be implemented by the Caribbean Epidemiology Centre; and
 - iii) the \$1.5 million Alliance for Sustainable Development project.
- Canada Fund disbursements in Belize amounted to \$300,000 in 1994-95. The fund supported 13 small-scale projects providing economic, technical and social development assistance to micro-enterprises, communities and development organizations.
- Total Canadian overseas development aid disbursements for 1994-95 through all channels, including multilateral agencies and international financial institutions, are estimated at \$1.07 million.
