

costs include civilian personnel costs, and on-base communications costs.

- (c) The obligation of the Government of the United States under paragraph 3 (b) above will not include costs associated with leased communications lines or equipment. The sharing of such costs will continue to be determined under the terms of existing or future agreements specifically applicable to such communications facilities.
- (d) The cost-sharing arrangements set forth in this agreement shall not apply to the financing of any capital improvements, such as new construction or installation of new equipment. The financing of such improvements, as well as any additional costs of operation and maintenance arising as a result of such improvements, shall be as agreed between the two Governments.

4. Liaison and supplementary arrangements

The United States Air Force or its designated agent will consult with the appropriate agencies of the Canadian Forces regarding the implementation of this agreement. Supplementary arrangements or administrative agreements between these agencies of the two Governments will be made from time to time for the purpose of carrying out the intent of this agreement. These arrangements or agreements will include procedures for the compilation, verification, and settlement of accounts.

5. Re-negotiation

Re-negotiation of this agreement may be requested by either Government in the event that the relative costs to either Government are significantly altered in the future.
