The Department of External Affairs announced today that Dr. Andrew Thomson, Controller of Meteorological Services, Department of Transport, will head the Canadian Delegation to the Second Congress of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), which opens in Geneva on Thursday, April 14, 1955. More than two hundred delegates representing some sixty countries will attend the four-week conference.
