

- “export”. (f) “export” means export from Canada;
- “exporter”. (g) “exporter” means a person who exports or agrees to  
export goods;
- “Minister”. (h) “Minister” means the Minister of Trade and  
Commerce; 5
- “person”. (i) “person” includes any association or partnership;
- “selling price”. (j) “selling price” includes insurance, freight or other  
charges paid or to be paid by the exporter on the  
buyer’s behalf.
- Sale of goods. (2) For the purposes of this Act a sale of goods to a 10  
buyer who intends to export them shall be deemed to be  
an export and the seller shall be deemed to be an exporter.”

**3.** The heading “Part I” immediately preceding section three of the said Act is repealed.
