My dear Senator:-

I thank you for your letter of the 16th and for your assurance that you will do what you can to assist in bringing to a satisfactory completion the scheme outlined to the Principal of The Montreal Technical School by Dean Adams.

I have been told that President Caron of the Technical School is having a conference to-day with Mr. Taschereau regarding further assistance to the Technical School to enable it to extend its plant. If the Province assists in any extension the machinery furnished by McGill would go a long way in supplying equipment which would be available to all classes of the Technical School.

I think, also, that the linking up in this small way of the Technical School with the University would be a good thing for both parties.
