

which has properties as powerful
as the radium itself. In fact this distribution
of the emanation is the usual procedure.

C. Supplies of emanation could be
issued in small sealed tubes to
the leading Medical Officers of
the Chief Hospitals for the actual
treatment of patients.

A representative committee of
chosen physicians would be required
to control the issue.

If a grant to McGill University is suggested
