SWEET SPIRIT OF NITRE

Sir,—I beg to hand you a report upon 73 samples of Sweet Spirit of Nitre, obtained by our inspectors during December, 1912, and January, 1913.

The report shows that 41 samples contain the legal amount of Ethyl Nitrite, while 32 samples contain less than the minimum permitted by the British Pharmacopæia.

As has been pointed out in former bulletins, and emphasized by the pharmacopæias, the article is prone to decomposition; and, unless kept with special care, will always deteriorate in the hands of the dealer. This fact is so well known to the drug trade that physicians have a right to expect special care on the part of the druggist, who is properly held responsible for the quality of the drugs he dispenses. The following table presents the results of three inspections of Sweet Spirit of Nitre:—
