

## CONSTITUTION.



*Article 1st.*—This Society shall be called “THE INFANT SCHOOL SOCIETY OF HALIFAX.”

*Article 2d.*—The object of this Society shall be to establish a School, where the Infant children of the poor may be taught various branches of useful knowledge, especially to instil into their tender minds, moral and religious instruction.

*Article 3rd.*—This Society shall be supported by annual subscriptions, and donations, collected by the Managers and friends of the Institution.

*Article 4th.*—This Society shall consist of a Patroness, Vice Patroness, Treasurer, Secretary, and a Committee of twelve married ladies, who shall each appoint two other ladies to assist them in their duties.
